About the Program

The Stanford Education Partnership for Internationalizing Curriculum (EPIC) Faculty Fellowship Program brings together a cohort of ten community college faculty and academic staff to work on projects aimed at developing global competencies and awareness amongst community college students.

- Visit the beautiful Stanford campus twice to attend a three-day workshop in August and come back to present your project outcomes at an end-of-the-year symposium in May.
- No cost to participate in the fellowship. Workshop meals and lodging will be provided for the summer workshop and end-of-the-year symposium, as well as travel expenses up to \$500 for each event.
- Participate in monthly virtual seminars with your cohort and Stanford faculty and staff.
- Develop materials and programs to implement in your classrooms and bring back to your home campuses.
- Join a growing network of EPIC alumni who are developing innovative programs to internationalize curricula.
