About the Program

The Stanford Education Partnership for Internationalizing Curriculum (EPIC) Leadership Program brings together a cohort of mid- and senior-level administrators from community colleges and MSIs across the United States to participate in leadership training and design programs at their home institutions to support global education.

- Visit the beautiful Stanford campus twice to attend a three-day leadership institute in August and come back to present your project outcomes at an end-of-the-year symposium in May.
- No cost to participate in the leadership program. Workshop meals and lodging will be provided for the summer leadership institute and end-of-the-year symposium, as well as travel expenses up to \$500 for each event.
- Participate in three quarterly virtual seminars that combine leadership training with presentations by leading Stanford faculty on timely topics in international education.
- Develop and implement a plan for institutionalizing international education on your home campus.
- Join a professional community of leaders dedicated to promoting international education.

This program is contingent upon U.S. Department of Education Title VI funding.
